Official Rules & Guidelines

General Guidelines

- Teams may check in starting at 7:00 am – 9am. Chili must be ready for sampling by 1pm.
- Chili must be cooked on site and from scratch. Complete chili mixes “just add meat” containing pre-measured spices is NOT permitted. Home - Canned vegetables and beans ARE NOT permitted
- Teams will bring their own tents, tables, decorations, cooking devices and utensils. Sampling cups and spoons will be provided.
- Each Team should prepare enough chili for 2 hours of sampling

Judging Information

- Refundable \$25.00 security deposit required. The security deposit will be refunded if the chili participants show up to the event and cleans their area after the contest.
- All chili will be judged by People’s Choice. Sampling will begin at 1pm and conclude at 3pm. The winners will be announced at 4pm.
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd place prizes will be awarded – plus 1st place winner will receive trophy & bragging rights for the year! Trophy will be passed on to next year’s winner.
- Refundable \$25.00 security deposit required. The security deposit will be refunded if the chili participants show up to the event and clean their area after the contest.

Health and Safety

Use good, clean methods of food preparation. Containers holding the chili MUST remain covered except when serving. The type of container must meet the Health and Safety regulations. All contestants must keep their chili at a serving temperature. Food items not stored in coolers must be stored up off the ground. Contestants may be subject to periodic inspections by County Health Officials to ensure compliance to all their Rules and Regulations. Each team is responsible for cleaning their area at the end of the day.

Failure to comply with officials on any matter is subject to disqualification of the individual cook. Decision of the officials is final.

The sponsors of this event will not be liable for any event or contract failure whatsoever caused by weather, act of god, etc.
